POLICY ON STUDENT TRUANCY

It is important to note that school attendance is critical to the successful school performance of all students. A true educational experience requires that a student participate actively in all aspects of the academic and co-curricular activities offered by the school. This active participation and all that it offers experientially can rarely be duplicated by any other means. The parent(s) and guardian(s) of our students have a moral and legal obligation to see to it that their sons and daughters attend school for the entire school year. In fact, this is a requirement under New Hampshire State Law RSA 193:1.

Tardiness:

Rules regarding tardiness -- Tardiness is determined by the school. Parents may not excuse school tardies; the school administration makes the determination.

- All tardies require a reason or an explanation to the school.
- Five (5) tardies (arriving after 8:01 a.m.) will trigger a 45 minute after school detention assignment.
- Five (5) school tardies (arriving after 8:01 a.m.) will result in the assignment of
